Lunch Duty - M-F 11:15-12:00 (1 hour credit) Help staff supervise/assist children during lunch/play time.

Classroom Help - Assist teacher with various classroom duties. Times are flexible.

Room Parent - Work with teacher to plan/organize "special" classroom activities; coordinate other classroom parent (Room parents will be given 2 hours of volunteer credit for coordinating classroom parties and assisting teacher with additional projects)

Box Tops and Campbell Soup Labels for Education Coordinator - Organize and send box top and label donations to obtain funds for the school. (Coordinator given 10 hours of credit for coordinating effort)

EmptyS for CaSh Coordinator - Collect/organize/send toner/ink cartridge/cell phone donations to obtain funds for the school. (Coordinator given 5 hours of credit for coordinating effort) (This position filled for this year)

Lunch Volunteer Hour Coordinator — Coordinate the scheduling of parent lunch volunteers (Coordinator given 10 hours of credit) (This position filled for this year)

HASA Leadership — Lead the parent organization by developing and managing school activities (HASA officers given 10 hours of credit for serving and actively participating in an appointed leadership position) HASA Member/ Committee Member — Attending HASA and other committee meetings to organize and plan events for the school (Attendee will be given credit for time attended)

Book Fair Assistants — Help run annual book fair by setting up or selling books (Time given for time served)

Burger King Coupon Book Coordinator — Coordinate annual sale of books and collection of money (Coordinator given 10 hours of credit for coordinating effort)

Event Chairperson — Chair a school-sponsored event (Chairs given 10 hours of credit for organizing and staffing the event)
