## Welcome New Members!

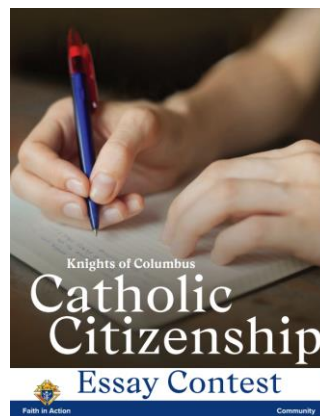
We welcome our newest member. Deacon Giovanni Munoz underwent Exemplification following the November Membership Meeting November 8<sup>th</sup>.

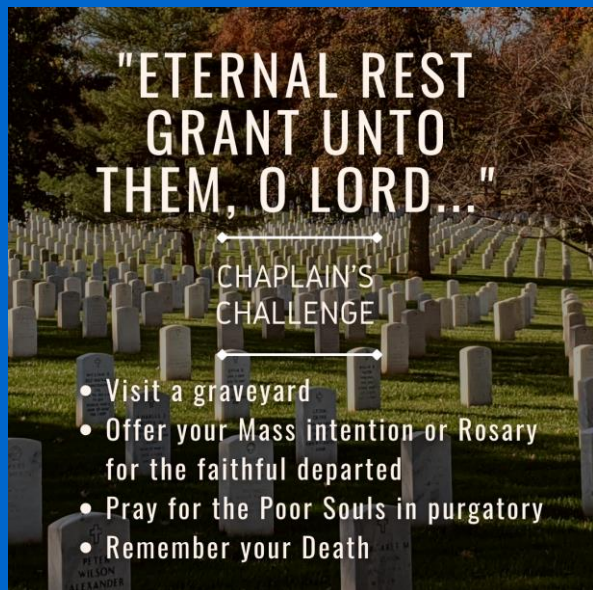
