I have been Rigby testing the class. This is a test to check what level a child reads at and their reading skills. Once all are complete I will group children according to their reading level/ability. The children will meet in small groups with me, at center time. We will work on reading books and practicing skills at their level. Your child will bring home a nightly Baggie called the "Bag Book". It contains a book and a slip of paper. Your child is to read the book(at least once) and get their slip signed. They then bring it back the next day to get a new book for homework.

This was the first week of March, so we talked about how March's weather can change a lot. We discussed the- In Like a Lion Out Like a Lamb(and vice versa) theory for the weather. We will be observing, assessing and recording the weather daily. We will determine whether it is a lamb or lion day. We will also be checking the theory to see if it ends up coming true. We decided March came in like a Lamb, so we predict it will go out like a Lion.
